STUDENTS MAY APPLY FOR **TWO HONOURS COURSES AND ONE GENERAL COURSE** AT THE MOST.

EACH APPLICATION IS TO BE MADE ON **SEPARATE** ONLINE APPLICATION FORMS.

APPLICATION FEE IS TO BE PAID **SEPARATELY** FOR EACH APPLICATION.

FOR EACH SUBJECT THERE MAY BE **SEPARATE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA** AND THE APPLICATIONS WITHOUT THE ELIGIBLE MARKS WILL BE SUMMARILY REJECTED DURING SCRUTINY.

AFTER FILLING UP THE ON-LINE FORM, **VERIFY** ALL DETAILS AND THEN SUBMIT THE FORM ONLINE.

YOU MAY TAKE A PRINT OUT OF THE APPLICATION FORM (FOR YOUR FUTURE REFERENCE) WHICH WILL COME ON THE SCREEN ON SUBMITTING THE FORM AND **MUST TAKE THE PRINTOUT OF THE BANK PAY-IN-SLIP.**

STANDING INSTRUCTIONS FOR C.B.C.S. SYSTEM

For **B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. (Honours)** - Student will have to choose **one Core Course (Honours)** from among the subjects offered in the drop down box and **two Generic Elective Courses, GE-1 and GE-2** from among the subjects offered in the drop down box.

For **B.A./B.Com. (General)**, student **chooses two Discipline Specific Core Courses, DSC-1A and DSC-2A and one Generic Elective, GE-1** from among the subjects offered in the drop down box. The B.A. course will be known as **B.A. [DSC-1 subject chosen (eg. B.A. in Bengali, if Bengali is chosen as DSC-1 subject)]** and the student will have to study **SEC** (Skill Enhancement Course) and **DSE** (Discipline Specific Electives) related to **DSC-1** subject chosen, in the following semesters.

For **B.Sc. (General)**, student **chooses three Discipline Specific Core Courses (DSC-1, DSC-2, DSC-3)**. The **B.Sc.** course will be known as **B.Sc. [DSC-1subject chosen (eg. B.Sc. in Chemistry, if Chemistry is chosen as DSC-1 subject)]** and the student will have to study **SEC** (Skill Enhancement Course) and **DSE** (Discipline Specific Electives) related to **DSC-1** subject chosen, in the following semesters.

INSTRUCTION TO STUDENTS FOR B.A./B.Sc./B.Com (Honours) COURSES

- SELECT COURSE **B.A./B.SC./B.COM (HONOURS)**;
- CHOOSE **ONE CORE COURSE (HONOURS)** FROM AMONG THE SUBJECTS OFFERED IN THE DROP DOWN BOX;
- **CHOOSE TWO GENERIC ELECTIVE SUBJECTS (GE-1 AND GE-2)** FROM AMONG THE SUBJECTS OFFERED.

INSTRUCTION TO STUDENTS FOR B.A./B.Com (GENERAL) COURSES

- SELECT COURSE **B.A. (GENERAL)**;
- CHOOSE **ONE CORE COURSE, DSC-1A** FROM AMONG THE SUBJECTS OFFERED IN THE DROP DOWN BOX AS YOUR MAIN SUBJECT;
- CHOOSE **DSC-2A** FROM AMONG THE SUBJECTS OFFERED IN THE DROP DOWN BOX;
- CHOOSE **ONE GENERIC ELECTIVE (GE-1)** FROM AMONG THE SUBJECTS OFFERED IN THE DROPDOWN BOX.

NOTE: B.A. course will be known as B.A. (DSC-1A subject chosen) [*eg.* B.A. in Bengali, if Bengali is chosen as DSC-1 subject] and you will have to study SEC (Skill Enhancement Course) and DSE (Discipline specific electives) related to your DSC-1A chosen, in the following semesters.

INSTRUCTION TO STUDENTS FOR B.Sc. (GENERAL) COURSES

- SELECT COURSE **B.SC. (GENERAL)**;
- CHOOSE **DSC-1** FROM AMONG THE SUBJECTS OFFERED IN THE DROP DOWN BOX AS YOUR MAIN SUBJECT;
- CHOOSE **TWO DSC-2A & DSC-3A** FROM AMONG THE SUBJECTS OFFERED IN THE DROP DOWN BOX.

NOTE: B.Sc. course will be known as B.Sc. (DSC-1 subject chosen) [*eg.* B.Sc. in Chemistry, if Chemistry is chosen as DSC-1 subject] and you will have to study SEC (Skill Enhancement Course) and DSE (Discipline specific electives) related to your DSC-1 chosen, in the following semesters.

GUIDELINES FOR ACCEPTABLE PHOTOGRAPH & SIGNATURE (FOR UPLOADING)

Before applying online a candidate will be required to have a scanned (digital) image of his/her photograph and signature as per the specifications given below.

Photograph Image

1. Photograph must be a recent passport size colour picture (4.5 cm high x 3.5 cm wide or 531px x 413px);
2. Taken against a light background;
3. Looking straight at the camera with a relaxed face;
4. Free from shadows;
5. If you have to use flash, ensure there is no “red-eye”;
6. Taken with the eyes open and clearly visible (without sunglasses or tinted spectacles, and no hair across the eyes);
7. With a neutral expression with the mouth closed (no grinning, frowning or raised eyebrows);
8. Of each person on their own (no other objects, or other people visible) taken with nothing covering the face;
9. Photographs must also be a recent true likeness of the individual, taken within the last 6 months;
10. If you wear glasses make sure that there are no reflections and your eyes can be clearly seen;
11. Caps, hats and dark glasses are not acceptable. Religious headwear is allowed but it must not cover your face;
12. Be free from airbrushing or similar enhancement (for example photographs must not be 'photo-shopped' or 'touched-up' or otherwise digitally altered);
13. Size of file should be between 5 kb – 50 kb.

Signature Image

1. The applicant has to sign on white paper with Black Ink pen;
2. The signature must be signed only by the applicant and not by any other person;
3. Size of the image should be (1.7 cm high x 10 cm wide or 53px x 288px);
4. Size of the file should be between 5kb – 50kb.
